Current and Future Opportunities for RIM Professionals: Where Do We Go From Here

Guest Speaker: Shari Perlstein

In this session we'll discuss various career opportunities for someone with a records management background. We'll also look at how companies' needs are changing, how this impacts the field and what new skillsets are required to stay current.



Shari Perlstein heads the Enterprise Records & Information Management (eRIM) function, part of Corporate Governance in Pfizer's Legal Division. eRIM empowers Pfizer colleagues to understand and comply with the Company's records & information management obligations by defining corporate policies, developing standards, and sponsoring services and solutions to support the consistent implementation and practice of records management principles throughout the enterprise. As part of this function, Shari and the eRIM team manage a network of strategic vendors throughout the world to aid in the long-term retention of physical records and partner closely with Pfizer's IT department to maintain proper retention of archived electronic records. eRIM oversees a service established to ensure timely retrieval of both physical and electronic archived records in support of business, regulatory and legal requirements. Shari joined Pfizer in 2003 where she was initially responsible for 21 CFR Part 11 Training globally. She has also held roles in Drug Safety R&D leading the Archive and Compliance function and Business Technology Quality & Compliance where she was responsible for BT Records Management and Global Policy. Shari earned a BA from the University of Michigan and an MBA from Pace University where she graduated with honors and currently serves on the Lubin School of Business Advisory Board.
