Allina Health is a not-for-profit health care system serving individuals, families and communities throughout Minnesota and western Wisconsin. Allina has more than 29,000 employees and 6,000 associated and employed physicians in 12 hospitals, 90+ clinics, 52 rehabilitation locations, 15 retail pharmacies, and 2 ambulatory care centers, in addition to providing a large number of specialty care services.

Allina's has an electronic medical record but their paper production has increased over the years. The Health Information Management (HIM) team determined that they needed to reduce this growing issue. As consultants in the clinics, they analyzed paper and developed recommendations for clinics to follow.
